



BAJALLION, S TEN YEAR FEAT OF NATION BUILDING IS ONE OF THE MOST OVERLOOKED AND UNDERRECOGNIZED STORIES OF MILITARY HISTORY. WITH THE DUAL GOALS OF POSSIBLY SHINING A BELATED LIGHT ON THE U.S. ABMY AND THE TROTH & UNIQUE ACCOMPLISHMENT, AND ANSWERING WEB SITE FOLKS REQUEST FOR IN FORMATION, I LIAVE COMPILED IN WORD AND PICTURE, A MORE DETAIN NUTS AND BOLTS, BOOTS ON THE GRO VERSION OF THAT 1952 BATALLIS BOOKLET. I HAVE FOUND THREE DIFFERENT WEB SITES RELATED TO THE 720 TH, AND PERHAPS ONE OF THEM COULD RELAY THE IN FORMATION AND PROVIDE THE NEEDED SPOTLIGHT. THE DARK AND TRAUMATIC DAY THAT WAS TO LIVE IN INFAMY, TRIGGERED THE JLOTH MILITARY POLICE BATALLION.S RENDEZVOUS WITH HISTORY.

IN RESPONSE TO, AND JUST FORTY EICHT DAYS LATER, ON JANUARY 20, 1942 THE BATALLION WAS OFFICIALLY ACTIVATED AT FORT MEADE, MARYLAND AND AND SOON BEGAN SEVERAL YEARS OF ACTIVE DUTY ASSIGNMENTS IN THE PACIFIC WAR THEATER.

THE SIGNING OF SURRENDER DOCUMENTS IN 1945 AUTHORIZED THE UNITED STATES MILITARY, UNDER THE COMMAND OF FIVE STAR GENERAL DOUGLAS M'ARTHUR, TO COMMENCE OCCUPATIONAL STATUS IN THE JAPANESE HOMELAND.

AS PART OF THAT OCCUPATION TEAM, IN SEPTEMBER OF 1945, THE TROTH M. P. BATALLION WAS DEPLOYED TO TOKYO, THE THIRD LARGEST CITY IN THE WORLD, TO INITIATE ITS HISTORIC POLICING AND SERVICING MISSION IN THAT CAPITAL CITY, AS AN IN TEGRAL PART OF THE OVERALL UNITED STATES OCCUPATION FORCE.

ANY BROADSTROKES PAINTING OF THE HISTORY OF THAT PACIFIC WAB CAMPAIGN AND THE RESULTANT OCCUPATION OF JAPAN, UNDERSTANDABLY, CANNOT DETAIL THE VITAL CONTRIBUTIONS OF INDIVIDUAL UNITS SUCH AS THE 720 TH M.P. BATALLION.

HOWEVER, THE BATALLION PROBABLY EARNED AND DESERVES EXEMPTION FROM SUCH ANONYMITY BY REASON OF TWO SEPERATE BUT INTERTWINED SUCCESSES.

FIRST, BECAUSE OF THEIR KEY, POINT GUARD ROLE IN THE INITIAL OCCUPATION AND REPATRIAZATION OF THE CAPITAL CITY FROM SEPETEMBER, 1945 TO FEBRUARY 1955, AND SECONDLY, BEGINNING IN APRYL 1952, THE ORDERLY TRANSITION OF GOVERNING AUTHORITY BACK TO SOVERIGN, JAPANESE RESPONSIBILITY.

BY ANY CRITERIA, THESE WERE TRULY UNIQUE AND MONUMENTAL UNDERTAINS S BECAUSE THEIR JURISDICTIONL MANDATE INCLUDED NOT ONLY ALL UNITED STATES AND ALLIED MILITARY, AND CIVILIAN PERSONEL, BUT THE JAPANESE CITIZENRY AS WELL.


THEIR CHARGE WAS EVEN FABTHER EXPANDED AND COMPLICATED WHEN THE KOREAN POLICE ACTION OF 1950 RESULTED IN THE ADDITION OF THOUSANDS OF MULTI NATIONAL, UNITED NATIONS MILITARY AND CIVILIAN PERSONEL TO THE MIX.

IN THE SUBJECT TIME FRAME, THE UNITED STATES MILITARY IN GENEBAL, AND THE M.P. BATALUON IN PARTICULAR, WEBE THE ARCHITECTS OF AN UNPRECEDENTED MILITARY ACHIEVEMENT AS THEY TRANSFORMED THE FORMER "LAND OF THE RISING SUN", FROM A BADLY DEFEATED, COMPLETELY DISORGANIZED, WAR DEVASTATED SHELL, TO A ONCE AGAIN INDEPENDENT, SELF-GOVERNING, SOVERIGN NATION CAPABLE OF EARNING ITS WAY BACK TO WOBLD ACCEPTANCE.

THIS ENDEAVOR DF THE UNITED STATES FORCES, WITH THE TOOTH IN ITS KEY TOKYO ROLE, MAY WELL BE ONE OF THE MOST OVER LOOKED, UNDER RELOGNIZED, ACHIEVEMENTS IN THE ANNALS OF MILITARY HISTORY.

AS THE OCCUPATION OF THE UNITED STATES MILITARY FORCES AROUND THE COUNTRY, AND THE TROTH IN TOKYO, APPROACHED THE TREATY MANDATED TASK OF GRADUALLY REDUCING SOLE U.S. AUTHORITY TO JOINT, AND THEN SOVERIGN JAPANESE CONTROL, MUCH OF THAT GOAL HAD ALREADY COPYRIGHT P.J. Cook 2010

ACCOMPLISHED. THE METROPOLITAN JAPANESE POLICE FORCE AND THE TROTH WERE ALBEADY POLICING IN AN INFORMAL, SHABED RESPONSIBILITY MODE OF TO EACH HIS OWN, WITH THE BATALION. S PRIMARY CONCERNS PITCHED TO UNITED STATES AND UNITED NATIONS PERSONEL. THE FOLLOWING NARBATIVE RELATES PRIMARILY TO THE YEAR 1952 AND THE DAYBY DAY, BACK-GROUND EVENTS WHICH FRAMED THE OVER-ALL SUCCESS OF THAT IMPORTANT, TRANSITORY VEOD YEAR. ITS GOAL IS A BOOTS ON THE GROUND, PICTURE OF WHAT I HAVE COME TO VIEW AS AN EPIC YEAR IN THE SIXTY EIGHT VEAR HISTORY OF THE BATALLION. THE TROTH WAS STILL IN PLACE AND FULFILLING THEIR OCCUPATIONAL ROLS, WHEN, ON CHRISTMAS EVE, 1951, MYSELF AND OTHERS ARRIVED AT THE TOKYO CAMP DRAKE REPLACEMENT DEPOT FOR DEPLOY-MENTTO KOREA AS FIELD ARTILLERY, FIRE DIRECTION SPECIALISTS.

WHILE AWAITING THE IMINENT ARRIVAL OF BARGES TO TRANSPORT US ACROSS THE BAY TO KOREA, AN OFFICER ENTERED THE HOLDING AREA AND ADVISED US THAT HE WOULD CALL A LIST OF NAMES AND IF YOU WERE CALLED AND WISHED TO REMAIN IN TOKYO AND BECOME A MILITARY POLICEMAN, TAKE ONE STEP FORWARD.

WITH THAT STEP, MYSELF AND THE OTHERS BELAME PLAYERS IN THE UP COMING, CRITICAL PERIOD OF BATALLION HISTORY.

WE WERE AMONG THE EARLIEST ARRIVALS TO BEGIN REPLACING THE OLDER, LONG TIME, REGULAR ARMY VETERONS WHO HAD POLICED AND SERVICED TOKYO IN OCCUPATIONAL MODE SINCE SEPTEMBER 1945.

THE ROLE OF THESE VETERANS, WHO HAD INITIALLY HELPED WIN THE WAR AND ESTABLISH THE OLCUPATION, AND WERE NOW ABOUT TO BEGIN IMPLEMENTING THE COpyright P. J. Cook 2010

PEACE, WOULD BE SIGNIFICANTLY ALTERED, BEGINNING IN FOUR MONTHS WITH THE RAPIFICATION OF THE JAPANESE PEACE TREATY IN APRIL 1952.

THAT TREATY WOULD SIGNAL THE BEGINN-ING OF THE LEGAL CHANGE OF THE UNITED STATES FROM PRIMARY OCCUPATIONAL STATUS TO SECONDARY SECURITY FORCE MODE.

IN THAT NEW ROLE AS SECURITY FORCE PERSONEL, THE REMAINING OLD GUARD, AND WE, THE NEW, WOULD BE CHARGED WITH BEGINNING THE TRANSITIONAL STEPS AND PROGRAMS MANDATED BY THE TREATY, TO GRADUALLY RETURN TOK JO TO SOVERIGN, SELF REGULATING, SELF GOVERNING AND SELF POLICING STATUS.


THAT TASK WAS FARTHER COMPLICATED BY THE NELESSITY TO TRAIN AND INTER-GRATE WE THE REPLACEMENT PERSONEL.

THUS WAS THE STATE OF FLUX IN WHICH I, AND THE OTHERS, ON THAT CHRIST MAS MOBNING, 1951, BEGAN OUB CONTRIBUTION TO THE BATALLION, S DATE WITH HISTORY.

FOLLOWING A PEBIOD OF INITIAL, IN HOUSE SCHOOLING BY HEADQUARTERS COMPANY, AND FIELD OBJENTATION BY THE OPERATING COMPANIES, WE WERE A SSIGNED TO THE OPERATING COMPANIES TO BEGIN FIELD DUTY. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT THIS INITIAL TRAINING WAS LATER AUGMENTED BY REGULARLY SCHEDULED, ADDITIONAL SCHOOLING PROGRAMS. SHORTLY AFTER MY COMPANY "A" ASSIGNMENT, I WAS CALLED TO HEAD-QUARTERS COMPANY AND GIVEN THE CHOICE OF REMAINING WITH CO. LIFE AND DUTY IN A STRUCTURED MILITABY ENVIBONMENT USUALLY FINDS A TWENTY FOUR HOUR, TWO PABT CYCLE, AND CAMP BURNESS WAS NO EXCEPTION. WE SOON FOUND OURSELVES IN A RYTHYM OF DAILY DUTY, IN THE FIELD OPERATION, AND OFF DUTY, IN HOUSE, REST AND RELBEATION. THE FOUR LINE COMPANIES WERE SCHEDULED TO PROVIDE THREE, EIGHT HOUR BOTATING SHIFTS, WITH HEADQUARTERS COMPANY AND ITS ATTACHMENT OF P.M.I.S (PROVOST MARSHALLS INVESTIGATIVE SERVICE) PER SONEL PROVIDING THE GLUE THAT HELD IT ALL TO GETHER. CAMP BURNESS, THE TOKYO HOME OF THE TROTH, HAD ITS MAIN GATE, FRONT ENTRANCE AT "Z" AVENUE AND ROTH ST. TN PREDCLUPIED JAPAN, THE FACILITY HAD BEEN THE HOME OF A JAPANESE COAST GUARD UNIT AND FOR THAT REASON THE REAR AREAS WERE FLANKED BY THE SUMIDA RIVER, AND IMPORTANT WATER WAY TO TOKYO BAY. 2010 P.J. "Z" AVENUE AND ZOTH STREET WEBE DOTTED WITH MOMAND POP SERVICE SHOPS LOCATED NEARBY TO CATER TO THE EVERY-DAY PERSONAL NEEDS OF THE CAMP BURNESS OCCUPANTS.

SHOBTLY AFTER ARBIVAL, A.G. T. USUALLY CAUGHT ON WITH A PARTICULAR "MOMMA SAN" OR SHOP TO SUPPLY HIS PERSONAL SERVICE NEEDS SUCH AS LAUNDRY, CLEANING AND PRESSING, TAILORING AND OTHER SPECIAL NEEDS.

MANY OF US, IN DEFERENCE TO AL-READY ESTABLISHED, HIGH LEVEL, PERSONAL AND GROUP STANDARDS, HAD MOST OF OUR G.I. ISSUED CLOTHING TAILORED TO PERSONAL FIT.


OF THESE MOM AND POP PEOPLE WAS TRULY AMAZING AND MUCH APPRECIATED.

AS AN EXAMPLE OF SPECIAL NEEDS, I STILL HAVE MY BRASS POLICE WHISTLE, FULLY ENGRAVED WITH CROSS PISTOLS, CO. A. TROTH M. P. BATALLION, YEAR 1952, IOKYO, JAPAN, AND THE ORDERLY REGULATION COAT OF ARMS WITH RESTRAINED IMP.






AS ANOTHER EXAMPLE, ON MAY 2, 1952, THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY OFFICIALLY APPROVED THE TROTH BATALLION COAT OF ARMS FEATURING THE RESTRAINED IMP, AND WITHIN DAYS WE WERE ABLE TO PUR CHASE THE FULL COLOR, BRASS UNIFORM PINS FROM MOM AND POP, WHICH MENUS THAT THOSE I HAVE ARE PROBABLY ABOUT AS OLD AS THEY COME. ABOUT THESE MOMAND POP FOLKS PROVIDED A MAJOR, NON COSTLY, BONUS SERVICE, IN THAT THEY WERE OFTEN THE FIRST TO PROVIDE US WITH KNOWLEDGE OR INFORMATION CONCERNING UPCOMING MAJOR OR MINOR CHANGES IN ALSO BATALLION OR FECOM STRUCTURE OR OLICY MOST OF THE MONETARY BARTERING WAS CONDUCTED IN AUTHORIZED, JAPANESE YEN, BUT ON OCCASSION OF SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE, NEITHER PARTY WAS ADVERSE TO AN EXCHANGE OF MILITARY SCRIPT FOR MUTUAL BENEFIT. 2010 P.J. DIFFERED GREATLY FROM THOSE OF OUR PREDECESSORS. MANY OF THE OLD GUARD HAD LONG ESTABLISHED, OFF BASE, LIVES AND HOUSING AND THEREFORE SPENT FAR FEWER OFF DUTY HOURS ON BASE. IN CONTRAST, MANY OF US SPENT MUCH OF OUR OFF DUTY HOURS IN ESTABLISHED MONTHLY, CYCLICAL ROUTINES AND PRACTICES. ONE SUCH CYCLE BEGAN WHEN THE "MYTHICAL PAY EAGLE", DEPOSITED OUR MONTHLY PAY IN MILITARY SCRIPT, NO U. S. DOLLARS, BECAUSE OF THE FLOURISHING BLACK MARKET IN U.S. NOI DOLLARS. THE EAGLES DEPOSIT ALWAYS TRIGGERED A NUMBER OF FORBIDDEN. POKER AND CRAPS GAMES THROUGHOUT THE COMPANY AND BATALLION AREA. THE INDIVIDUAL SITE WINNERS PROGRESSIVLY CONSOLIDATED, AND AT THE END OF A 24 TO 36 HOUR PERIOD, THERE WERE SOME TRULY HIGH ROLLER SCRIPT DOLLARS CHANGING HANDS. (C) 2010 P.J. COOK Copyright P. J. ANOTHER MONTHLY CYCLE REVOLVED AROUND GIGARETTES. ONCE A MONTH ALL BRIALLION MEMBERS WERE ENTITLED TO PURCHASE AN ALLOTMENT OF U.S. CIGARETTES FROM THE BATALLION P.X. AT BARGAIN P.X. PRICES.

AGAIN, BECAUSE OF A LUCRATIVE BLACK MARKET IN U.S. CIGARETTES, THE FOLLOWING DAYS WERE A STUDY IN FREE WHEELING MONETARY EXCHANGES BETWEEN THE SMOKERS AND NON SMOKERS, AND YOU WOULD BE CORRECT IF YOU GUESSED THAT SOME OF THOSE GIGARETTES LATER WERE A FORM OF BARTER EXCHANGE WITH MOM AND POP.

IN HOUSE, THE TOO TH FIELDED SPORTS TEAMS AND INDIVIDUALS WHO COMPETED. REGULARLY WITH OTHER LOCAL MILITARY UNITS.

THOSE OF US WHO WEBE NOT TALENTED ENOUGH TO COMPETE AT THAT LEVEL, ENJOYED HOURS OF RECREATION TIME AS SPECTATORS AT THOSE EVENTS, AND AS ACTIVE PARTICIPANTS IN COMPANY LEVEL, INTRA-MURAL SPORTS PROGRAMS.

SOME OF MY MOST PLEASANTAND ENJOYABLE MEMOGIES SPRING FROM THAT FACT.

AT THE END OF THE 3 TO II PM OR THE II TO TAM TOUR, WE WOULD COME TOGETHER IN THE MESS HALL TO RELAX AND WIND DOWN, SHARING STORIES AND EVENTS OF THE JUST COMPLETED EIGHT HOUR TOUR.

AS YOU MIGHT EXPECT, SOME OF THEM BECAME LEGENDARY AS TIME AND REPETITION EMBELLISHED THEM.

AS GROWING YOUNG MEN, THESE SESSIONS WEBE EVEN MOBE ENJOYABLE BECOUSE THERE WERE NO LIMITS ON THE AMOUNT OF FOOD OR BEVERAGE AVAILIABLE FOR OUR EAGLY MOBNING BREAKFAST OR LATE EVENING SUPPER.

OUR MESS HALL WAS EVEN FURTHUR APPRECIATED BY ALL OF US BECAUSE IT DID NOT FEATURE THE UNIVERSALLY DISLIGED, K.P. DUTY.

THOSE DUTIES WERE PERFORMED BY JAPANESE LIVILIAN WOBBERS PAID FROM A VOLUNTARY, BATALLION WIDE FUND TO WHICH ALL CONTRIBUTED.

ANOTHER OUTSTANDING, BUT SOMETIMES PAINFUL MEMORY OF EVERYDAY ROUTINE INVOLVED A DAILY CHECKING OF THE COMPANY BULLETIN BOARD.

ON IT WAS A FREQUENTLY UPDATED POSTING OF THE NAMES OF THE AMERICAN KOREAN WOUNDED NEWLY ADMITTED TO TOKYO ARMY HOSPITAL.

WHEN WE FOUND THE NAME OF ANY OF OUR FRIENDS FROM OUR ARTILLERY BASIC TRAINING GROUP, IT MEANT A SOMETIMES PAINFUL VISIT TO THE HOSPITAL.

ON DECASSION, THE INJUGED COMBADE Was THE VICTIM OF SERIOUS DISFIGUREMENT OB LIMB LOSS WHICH ALWAYS LEFT ME WITH MELONCHOLY THOUGHTS OF WHY THE LUCK OF THE DRAW HAD ME STANDING THERE AS THE FORTUNATE VISITOR, AND HE THE BED RIDDEN VICTIM.

EACH COMPANY HAD A BECBEATION DAY BOOM FEATURING PINGPONG AND POOL TABLES, CARD PLAYING AND LETTER WRITING AREAS, AND EVEN QUIET READING AREA.

THE CARD GAMES OF CHOICE WERE POKER AND HEABTS. IF, AS EARLIED REPORTED, HIGH STAKES POPER WAS PAY DAY "KING" IN THE BATALLION, THE "QUEEN OF SPADES" AND HER THIRTEEN HEARTS OFTEN RULED THE DAY ROOM.

WHILE THERE WERE SOME LOW STAKES POKER GAMES, AND THE OBJECTS CHANGING HANDS ON THE TABLE, USUALLY HADA WORTH IN EXCESS OF FACE VALUE, THE HEARTS PLAYERS WERE A SERIOUS PRESENSE.

THOSE PLAYERS TOOK GREAT PRIDE IN THEIR INDIVIDUAL AND TEAM SKILLS, AND THE GAMES WERE FIERCELY COMPETETIVE WITH THE WINNERS SUME-TIMES EXTENDING THEIR CHALLENGE TO OTHER COMPANIES.

THE BATALLION SERVICE CLUB FEATURED A FULL TIME, U.S.O. TYPE HOSTESS WHO, THROUGHOUT THE YEAR SCHEDULED AND AND HOSTED SPECIAL ENTERTAINMENT NIGHTS AND EVENTS.

OF HOLIDAY CHEER AND HOME MEMORIES, WITH HER MAJOR HOLIDAY THEMES AND PRESENTATIONS.

I DO NOT KNOW WHAT EXACT OVER-ALL STANDARDS AND QUALIFICATIONS WERE IN PLAY WHEN INDIVIDUALS WERE SELECTED TO SERVE IN THE BATALLION, BUT THE PERSONAL MORALS BAR MUST HAVE BEEN VERY HIGH INDEED.

WITH FEW EXCEPTIONS, THE INDIVIDUALS ENTRUSTED WITH THE BATALLION GOAL OF OBDERLY REGULATION WERE A CREDIT TO THAT TRUST, BOTH ON AND OFF DUTY.

INTERNAL INCIDENTS OF SERIOUS DISCIPLINE WERE RARE, AND I PERSONALLY SAWFEW INCIDENTS OF THE "POWER TRIP" REACTION SOMETIMES MANIFESTED WHEN SOME INDIVIDUALS DONNED THE ARM BAND OF AUTHORITY.

WHILE ABOARD THE TROOP TRANSPORT SHIP, THE U.S.S.
