- I._GENERAL. 1. Under the provisions of paragraph 36a(2), AR 672-15, announcement is made of staff sections and units not physically located within the territorial limits of Korea which have been designated by the Commander in Chief, Far East, as having directly supported the military effort in Korea.
- 2. The Korean Service Medal and United Nations Service Medal may be awarded to personnel of the United States Army assigned to any of the units listed below during the periods indicated. Temporary duty with one or more of these units for 30 or more consecutive days or 60 or more nonconsecutive days during the periods indicated will establish eligibility for these medals. Service which meets the requirements for the Korean Service Medal will not be considered in determining eligibility for award of the Army of Occupation Medal. No individual will be awarded more than one Korean Service Medal.
- 3. When recording individual credit this General Order may be cited as authority for such entries.
